Am Montag habe ich die **Aktionspläne** zur Energieeffizienz und zur Förderung erneuerbarer Energien vorgestellt. An der Medienkonferenz konzentrierten sich die Fragen bald darauf, ob mit diesen Massnahmen ein Kernkraftwerk eingespart werden könne. Diese Frage hat mich etwas überrascht, weil es bei den Aktionsplänen ja nicht nur um den Strom, sondern auch um Wärmenutzung und den wichtigen Bereich Mobilität geht, die mit den KKW gar nichts zu tun haben. Meine Antwort war, dass wir auf den Bau von Gaskraftwerken verzichten können und zumindest keine zusätzlichen KKW bauen müssen, wenn wir alle Massnahmen umsetzen.

Mittlerweile habe ich die Rechnung noch etwas genauer gemacht: Wenn wir bei den erneuerbaren Energien mit unseren Massnahmen und den neuen Einspeisevergütungen 3500 Gigawattstunden zulegen und den Stromverbrauch auf dem Niveau von 2006 stabilisieren können (ohne Massnahmen würden wir 2020
