On Wednesday 25th April, immediately following the RE 01 Program Committee meeting, there will be a workshop on requirements engineering at Imperial College, London, hosted by Dr. Alessandra Russo. The Workshop is open for RE 01 PC members and ISRE & ICRE Steering Committee members. All PC and Steering committee members are invited to submit a position paper of max. three pages about one of the following topics. Please submit by email in pdf format to the program chairs.

- Problem frames in requirements engineering
- Software requirements and systems engineering
- Abstraction levels in requirements engineering
- Natural language and requirements engineering

At the Workshop, these topics will be discussed in four discussion blocks of about 90 minutes each. The Workshop chairs will select a number of position papers for presentation and assign to each of these a critic. The discussion of each paper is started by a presentation by the author, followed by a critique by the critic, after which discussion is open to the floor. After the Workshop, the papers and a workshop summary will be made available on a web site by the Workshop chairs.
